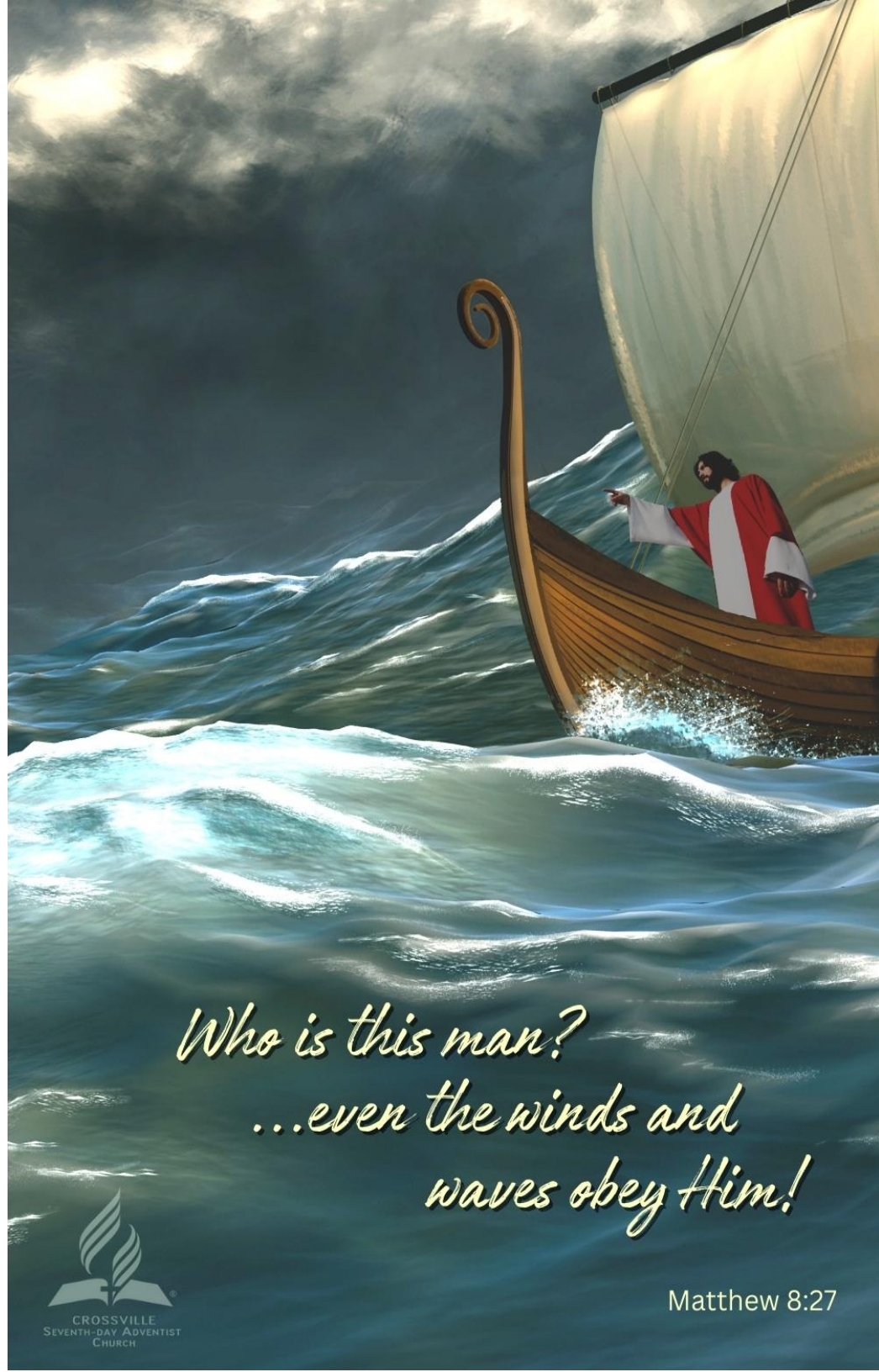

# BUGEMA UNIVERSITY Vocational School PROJECT

## THE NEED IN UGANDA CONTINUES...

Dear Crossville Church Family,

Chad and I and three others are once again gearing-up for a mission trip to Uganda, flying out on Sunday 21 May. As per my trip in January, one of our goals is to continue facilitating the Bugema University Vocational School program.

The \$17,000 sent last July for the building addition to the mechanics program has been well spent and that addition will be in operation when we arrive there in May.

The donated tools and \$1,000 for tool purchase and the set-up of the mechanics tool room effected in January is providing much needed hands on opportunities for students. I hope to take the rest of the donated used tools and also purchase additional specialty tools and mechanics textbooks. The textbooks will be kept in the library.

The next area I hope to focus attention on is the recently initiated Culinary Arts certificate and diploma programs which are about two years in the making. The Culinary Arts program was begun Jan. 2022 in a 20' x 30' shipping container. It has since moved into a 12' x 30' add-on to another building. A whole new building to house the C.A. program is about one-half completed. When completed it will provide a large equipped teaching kitchen, a restaurant area to serve the public (the school is on a main thoroughfare) and generate funds for the program. Thus I am seeking assistance in raising funds for:

- 1. Additional mechanics specialty tools & textbooks ----- \$ 1,800.00
- 2. Materials to complete the Culinary Arts building ----- \$27,000.00

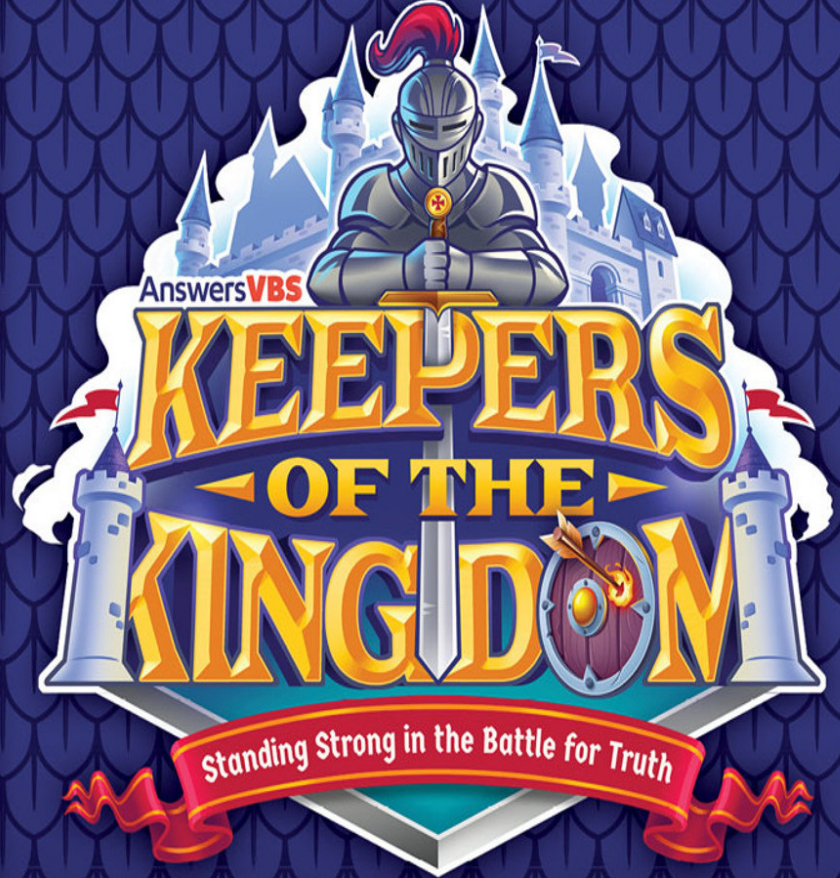
Thank you and may the Lord impress you as to what you might do to help see this project to completion be it your much sought after prayers and or financial assistance.
